


VOLUNTEERING



In the two years of studying at St. John's Preparatory, he has won the President's Medal of Honor for several consecutive years with an average score of 100 or higher. He also took multiple AP courses in grades 11 and 12 and has been re-elected as a member of the school's International Honor Association. In his senior year, he won the school-level honorable mention with a perfect SAT math score. "I think that two years of experience in St. John's High School has allowed Emory to see my potential and strengths, which has made me stand out from other applicants and finally get an offer."

Adel was accepted by the Columbia University in 2024. During her studies and life at St. John's Prep, Adel developed a high degree of self-discipline and learned to use his time as efficiently as possible. In addition to her outstanding performance in her classes, she has held multiple positions, from active community members, volunteer organizations, to teaching assistants, enriching his extracurricular life, and actively integrating into the local life in the United States. "When I first entered this school, I was very introverted and not confident in my English. But every student was friendly and enthusiastic to me. The teachers here were friendly and patient. They cared for me and were willing to help me as much as possible. They always answer my questions patiently and carefully to make sure I understand what they mean."

Hannah is part of the class of 2023 and was accepted by New York University. For four consecutive years, she has been awarded the Principal's Medal of Honor, a member of the International Honors Association, and a SAT Mathematics Perfect Score holder. In terms of school activities, she actively participated in many community activities, such as helping head Chinese Culture Club and Red Storm Café. In her spare time, she actively participated in volunteer activities around New York City to enrich her high school life. "I feel like I am a part of this school. St. John's Prep is a relatively small school, so I have the opportunity to meet almost every teacher and classmate.
