Download the Libby app from your app store. Then sign up for our local library and you will be able to download ebooks to read on your phone or tablet. I am reading Fish Up a Tree by Lynda Mullaly Hunt on my tablet now - it's really good.</p>	<p>Read Winn Dixie Chapter 22 In a google document or word document explain who your favorite character in the chapter is. Your writing should explain why this character is your favorite and give three reasons that this character is your favorite character. The reasons may be from Chapter 22 or from before Chapter 22. Remember Mrs. Dean's talks with us.
