


Remote Learning Plan for 4th Grade

Reading	<p>Read <u>at least</u> 40 minutes each day (both Monday and Tuesday). If you read a page per minute - that's 40 pages. Set a goal for yourself and don't stop until you get there. "At least" means that you can read more than 40 minutes, but not less than 40 minutes. You can access it through Google Classroom. Use the same signon you do at school.</p> <p>Read Tale C5 on Monday and C6 on Tuesday. Make sure you use the right voices - Furlough is an overdramatic teenager voice. Lester is an older dad voice. Antoinette is a high french voice worried mostly about herself. Lester is a coward and does not speak up for his son. It is also very dramatic but in a different, scary sort of way.</p>	<p>Read at least 35 minutes on Friday. Read at least 25 minutes on Saturday and Sunday. If it's bad weather read at least 40 minutes each day! Haha</p> <p>Update the google spreadsheet with what book you are reading and what page you are on. You can access it through Google Classroom. Use the same signon you do at school.</p> <p>Read Tale C9 on Friday and C10 sometime over the weekend. Maybe the whole book is dramatic - this chapter is too! Remember the Head mouse is very loud and obnoxious and Despereaux is a little bit scared and small - that's how he talks.</p> <p>Several times in the story, the author is making ties to fairy tales that are told to kids.
