Mass Security

While our thoughts and prayers are with our brothers and sisters in Minneapolis, we want to assure our St. Adalbert parent partners that we are doing everything possible to keep our students safe and secure during their time with us. The Diocese has asked all schools in our system to review plans for safety and assess need. Please know that we are making changes, adding more cameras, moving staff, and adding procedures to do everything in our power to keep your children safe.

It is central to our Catholic faith that we do not block people in need of God's loving grace from their access to Him. For that reason, we will always have some guests at school Masses. This is also something beautiful about our community. We would like to take this opportunity to invite our parent partners to join us for school Mass. While the primary benefit of joining our school community for Mass each week is time spent in prayer with the Lord, it also increases our sense of community, teaches your students that you value your faith, and honestly increases the safety of our students. When we have a strong showing of parents sitting on the outside rows of the church, we increase the amount of eyes watching out for our beloved children in the event of an emergency.

It is also of note that, moving forward, the only door open for school Masses will be the door closest to the school. Once Mass begins, students and guests will need to knock on those doors and wait to be admitted by school staff. This means that parents of tardy students will need to park their car, get out, and walk their students to the church in order to ensure that they are safe.

Lastly, please know that our team at St. Adalbert School will be working with the Catholic Schools Office and local authorities to continue to increase school security in all aspects. We appreciate the gift of your trust in such trying times and ask your prayers as we continue this crucial work.
