Book Report Details

<u>The book report is due on Friday, March 27.</u>

You have three options. Choose one of the following options to complete for your book report. You only need to complete one of the options.

Option 1: google slide presentation.

You will create a google slide presentation and share it with Ms. Bogol.

You will have at least 9 slides.

Slide 1: Your name and date

Slide 2: name of the book and author

Slide 3: information about the author

Slide 4-6: about the book- characters, setting, problem, solution, etc.

Slide 7: Short 5-7 sentence summary of the book

Slide 8: At least 3 questions about the book. Think of it like you are creating a 3 question AR quiz for the book you

read

Slide 9: the answers to the 3 questions from slide 8

You can find an example on google classroom.

Option 2: 5 paragraph essay (handwritten or typed).

You will write or type a 5 paragraph essay about your book and share the doc with Ms. Bogol if you type it. If you handwrite it please write it in your writing notebook. The essay should include the following:

The book's title The author of the book and information about the author A summary of the book that includes: The setting of the book The characters in the book The problem in the book The solution in the book Discuss if you would recommend the book to a friend. Why or why not? What was the best part? Etc.

Option 3: Graphic Novel/Comic Strip of book

Complete in your writing notebook. Turn your book into a comic strip/graphic novel.

Requirements:

Your comic strip should have a minimum of 10 squares.

Each square should have a hand drawn image and word bubbles or captions.

Your drawings should look like you took time to do them.

Color it if you can, but it is not a requirement to be colored.
