Maybe, as a way of saying "thank you" to God, you can do something special or helpful for your family today. How can you love your family like God loves you?</p>		<p>2) <b>Talk with your family</b> about the reading. Here are some things to talk about:</p> <p>—Jesus says that Lazarus' sickness would reveal God's glory. In other words, God is able to bring good even out of bad situations! When has God brought something good out of a seemingly bad time in your own life? (You might consider, for example, the Coronavirus situation!)</p> <p>—The shortest verse in scripture is "Jesus wept" (John 11:35). Jesus wept because he loved Lazarus so much. Are there times you have trouble expressing your feelings? What does Jesus' example teach us?</p> <p>3) <b>Pray the "Our Father" together</b> as you ask Jesus to bring goodness out of your struggles.</p> <p>4) <b>Draw a picture</b> of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead! Pay attention to how Lazarus is described in the Gospel. <b>Color it</b>, if possible.</p>
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
