Due to the poor weather this winter, we WILL HAVE SCHOOL IN SESSION on both Monday, February 16th (President's Day) and Thursday April 2nd (Holy Thursday).

Additionally, we will have asynchronous elearning days on Friday, February 13th, Monday, March 16th, and Friday April 3rd. On these three days, children will not be in the school building but will work from home. Work will come from teachers via Remind at 7:30 those mornings. **It is imperative that we have good support from our parent partners in order to make this work for our school community.** Please respond to those Reminds from teachers in timely manner and make sure your students complete their work. Work from this day will be counted in their final grades. Missing or late work will unfortunately penalize student grades and we want to avoid that as much as possible.

Dismissal

We want to thank our parent partners for their patience and cooperation with drop off and dismissal in inclimate weather these past few weeks. Your help has enabled us to keep our students warm and safe, out of the dangerous cold and we are most appreciative.

Please do keep in mind that, even when you are in a hurry, or having a tough day, these staff members are showing up for your kiddos. Standing in extreme weather directing traffic, taking names, loading up kiddos...these tasks are not part of teacher's role. They are tasks that these generous team members volunteered for on top of all that they already do because they genuinely love your children and are willing to be uncomfortable to keep them safe. Your cooperation in following procedures, being polite, refraining from honking or making negative comments is all the appreciation that they expect. But a thank you here and there also goes a long way.

Enrollment

Returning student enrollment for grades K-8 is now open as in our PK enrollment. Forms went home in last week's Friday Folder but if you need an additional copy, we are happy to provide them in the school office. Please keep in mind that returning families who have paid or made arrangements to pay their tuition balance will not be able to re enroll until they have done so. If you need help in making financial arrangements, please know that we are willing to help if you call the school office.

Returning family enrollment ends on February 28th and after that, all students are considered new students, meaning that they could be subject to wait lists in some of our fuller classes. That best way to avoid waitlists is to return your completed forms at tuition payments before February 28th.

New student enrollment opens March 1 and we need your help!

Returning families who refer a new family will receive two hours off their current service hour balance. There is no limit on the number of families you can refer. So if you are behind on service hours and know some great families in need of a new school, please consider encouraging them to apply for enrollment at St. Adalbert.
