Covid Update #11

Dear Parents,

In the last ten days, the guidance from federal, state, and local authorities regarding reopening schools has been coming in at a rapid pace, and school districts are adjusting their plans for bringing students back to school. After considering the advice of local health experts, we believe our reopening plan is very safe for all students and staff. We are still planning to begin with half of our students in the morning and half of the students in the afternoon for each class, **however**, **we are changing our start date for students to Wednesday**, **August 26**. This extra week will ensure that we have time to prepare our building with more sinks for handwashing, new water bottle filling stations, and fresh coats of paint.

If you have not already completed the survey regarding our first weeks of school, be sure to indicate your preference for either the morning or afternoon session as soon as possible. For families that are unable or choose not to send students for in person instruction, there is an 100% virtual option available - again, please contact the school to indicate this preference. Our plan is to do the morning and afternoon sessions with half of each class until at least September 25. We will decide in the middle of September whether it is safe to start full days with full classes after September 25.

Communication between the school and our families is critical at all times - but especially now during this rapidly developing situation with the Coronavirus and the start of the school year. Our fastest form of communication with all of you right now is our Remind Text Message application, along with our newly formed YouTube channel. We will continue to utilize both of these sources to keep you up-to-the-moment in news and announcements related to St. Adalbert School. If you are not already signed up for both, please do so NOW by following the directions on the pages enclosed in this mailing.

Please continue to watch your text messages and check our YouTube channel so that as the beginning of the year details continue to unravel, your family can remain informed.
