Reading	<p>Read <u>at least</u> 40 minutes each day (both Monday and Tuesday). If you read a page per minute - that's 40 pages. Set a goal for yourself and don't stop until you get there. "At least" means that you can read more than 40 minutes, but not less than 40 minutes</p> <p>Leave a comment on the Google classroom class feed telling what book you're reading and what page you are on. If you finish a book, tell us all how you liked it!</p> <p>On WD page 153 ( I know we already read that chapter) the preacher says a blessing for the party before they eat. Read it carefully - two of my favorite lines in the book are in that prayer.</p> <p>1. Guess what the lines are and why I like them (you can't be wrong, but make sure you give 2-3 reasons why you think I like those lines....or why YOU like them? Some of you may have seen it. I copied it on a notecard and tacked it up at my desk. It says "There ain't no way you can hold on to something that wants to go, you understand? You can only love what you got while you got it."</p> <p>Every year as the school year goes on and my class gets closer and closer to going to 5th grade, I think about this line. I know you all want to and will grow up and that I only "get" you for a short one school year. I have to make the best of that year with all of you and love you while I get to have you close to me everyday.</p>	<p>Read at least 35 minutes on Friday. Read at least 25 minutes on Saturday and Sunday. If it's bad weather read at least 40 minutes each day! Haha</p> <p>Leave a comment on the Google classroom class feed telling what book you're reading and what page you are on.</p> <p>Remember that Winn Dixie has run away in C23. Now read C24 (it's the longest one in the book i think). If you already read it - read it again.</p> <p>Summarize the chapter. It should be a little longer because there is a lot going on. 6-10 sentences.</p>
