A New Home

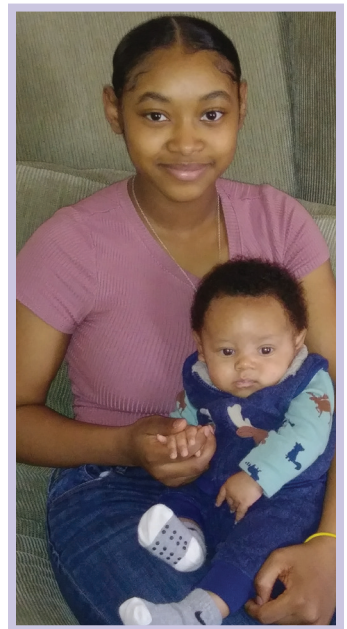
God provided an avenue earlier this year for Beerlahai Roi to purchase a bigger and better home to meet the ongoing needs of the ministry. Several potential new residents that were homeless and pregnant with another child were calling the home on Olde Carriage Way seeking refuge. At this house we were grateful to shelter women and babies for 11 years, but we're unable to accommodate toddlers due to the steps.

As it turned out, God had a specific plan for this stage of ministry even though we had to let His plan unfold. His Word says to "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;

in all your ways submit to Him and He will make your paths straight." (Proverbs 3:5-6). We were having a difficult time locating a new home that would be the right size for our residents and their children but we were determined to put our trust in the Lord's direction.

One Sunday afternoon, a ministry board member became aware of a lovely home for sale that sounded like it would be a perfect fit. Following a visit to the new home, we believed God was leading us to make an offer and purchase the home. We believe God provided the new home at 3128 Superior Drive in Springfield to allow pregnant women to have another child up to two years of age and stay until their unborn child is two years. The home also provides our residents with public transportation two blocks away.

Please pray with us as we continue to move forward providing more opportunities to homeless pregnant women in crisis. As a joyful testimony, we sold our former home to a young family who fell in love with it knowing it was a place where unwed mothers could be assisted. The woman of the family was herself once an unwed mother. We praise God for His plan coming to pass and His hand upon Beerlahai Roi Women's Ministries.
