# 25 years of God's provision

The greatest gift the last 25 years is the way God has shown His love to all the women that have lived at Beerlahai Roi. Psalm 36:5 says "Your love, Lord, reaches to the heavens . . ." We have witnessed many miracles since opening in 1998.

One recent resident named Kay, 24, found herself nine months pregnant, on the streets and homeless. Her two young daughters had been taken into custody by the state because she was in an abusive relationship. Her life was a mess and things were very hard. A local

agency referred her to our ministry and she delivered her precious son on September 3, 2022.

Two days later, the state took her newborn son into custody while she was still in the hospital. She was separated from her son and was in a very difficult place. She called out to God asking for another chance.

We went to court with Kay and watched as God showed Himself strong. He answered her prayer and the judge ordered her son returned to Beerlahai Roi because of its good reputation and help to the community.

Many tears of joy were cried that day and we finally were able to see Kay smile. A few weeks later Kay surrendered her heart to the Lord and received Him as Savior. She now has her own place to live and is attending nursing school. An educator who volunteers for Beerlahai Roi, Kay Engel, worked with Kay and taught her GED classes. She extended those classes to her even after she moved out of the resident house. To God be the alory!

For the judge to allow a baby to be returned to the home was God's favor. Our hope has been for Jesus to be lifted up in our community. Witnessing God answer the prayers of our residents has been awesome to see. The Lord has provided a new start and direction for hundreds of women from many different walks of life.
