Still Figuring It All Out

Meet Nickie. Before coming to BeerLahai Roi Women's Ministries a few months ago, she had spent time in and out of various shelters for about a year. A history of addiction and abuse left her ill equipped, and when she found she was pregnant, she didn't know where to turn. "I had nothing and nobody," she said. "This is the first place I've felt at home."

Part of life for everyone at the residence home is attending church together on Sunday mornings. Nickie shared, "I was never

religious. I don't think I'd ever even been in a church before. The sermon on the first Sunday I went was on Hope, and it spoke to me." She has accepted Jesus

as her savior, and her life has changed. She feels His love and protection, and has experienced compassion and care from His people at church and BeerLahai Roi.

Generous donors recently gifted her a car. Having her own transportation allows her to work long shifts, opening and/or closing at times when buses are not



available, and will be invaluable for getting her baby to daycare when she returns to work after maternity leave.

When asked about her plans after her son arrives in mid-September she said, "I don't' really know yet, maybe school or a 'real job'. I'm still figuring out who the new me is."

Please pray for all the women staying at the BeerLahai Roi Women's Ministries home, that God would guide and direct them as they find their way into a happy future for themselves and their young families.
