Samantha is focused on her commitments and obligations while awaiting the arrival of her baby in June. "It's peaceful here with lots of serenity," she said. "I have a lot of anxiety and I've been learning coping skills and trying to keep things stress free."

Samantha said she has read the Bible a lot while staying at the home and sees her time here as a "help and a hope." Being here has allowed me to take a breath and focus on God and provide good care for my baby when it comes. I don't have to worry about paying rent or other things.

"When I found out I was pregnant, I was at a very low time in my life and I opened the Bible and was comforted by knowing that God has a plan for me," she said.

Debbie Tobin, Beerlahai Roi's housemother, agreed that Samantha is working on her relationship with God but also developing relationships with other residents and taking time to get her chores done.

"With all our residents, it's a work in progress,"

Tobin said. "I'm just grateful there is a place where these ladies can call home while they are getting ready to deliver and recover. They don't have to be on the streets and all their needs are met. God has made that possible," she said.
