In my past work I was in several job positions at Microsoft

As a Technical Support Associate, I learn to deal with customers over the phone and provide support for Windows 1.0 & 2.0 and Excel 2.0. I homed my skills in support by designing a problem-solving chart which proved to teach in associates and make their work easier.

Later on, at Microsoft, I worked as a Software Test Engineer and developed my problem-solving skills and trouble shooting. This allowed me to grow into a Management position for Windows 95 Printer Test team where I hired the staff. I received a Ship It award from Bill Gates for my work.

As a manager I was dealing with Program Managers and helping them with their jobs. I was in training to take over the Program Managers' position. But before that I was promoted to a Lead Test Engineer position in testing. I learned how to manage people and training them to test software printer testing problems.

This experience allowed me to start my own company and train software testers for Microsoft. I trained over 200 software testers for Microsoft during my ownership of InterTest.com. I built several computer labs which I learned at Microsoft and wrote 5 training manuals for testing and computer hardware.

During this time, I trained at several colleges Software Testing. I worked at Shoreline CC, Portland CC, and Green River CC.

Now I am taking on AI Healthcare in a big way. My Cancer research program should save lives by early detection of Cancer.
