# The Skeleton Key

Unlocking the doors to a deeper understanding of the Bible, this Skeleton Key centers solely on the beginning: The First Pages of the Holy Scripture. It lives on the symbols and meanings buried beneath the words; a Math and its mirror, Science, invented through God's Operative traits from the birth of existence to the operating system of Humanity.

The disciples said to Jesus: "Tell us how our end will be."

Jesus said: "Have you already discovered the beginning that you are now asking about the end?

For where the beginning is, there the end will be too. Blessed is he who will stand at the beginning. And he will know the end, and he will not taste death."

Genesis 1:1-1:4

(+)

Genesis 1:1-1:4 In the beginning, God created (created means to add (+) into existence) the Heaven and the Earth (because 1:2 the Earth was empty and formless [without form and void] and Darkness was upon the face of the deep). Continuing to Genesis 1:3, where God said, "Let there be Light," and there was Light (Light was added (+) into existence, granting all creations the ability to be perceived in the only way things can be perceived [the primary function of the eye® a sensory organ. Its main function is to collect Light and convert it, sending and processing it to the brain to form or identify images and visual detail/specifications]).

Genesis 1:4 And God saw (Saw® indicates that God now has perception® and has a visual® component through the creation (+) of Light) the Light, that it was Good. (Good is, in its foundation and at its root, a positive (+) energy. The first definition of Good is 1) 'Being Positive in nature'. Its definitions all fall under the umbrella of the Positive, which is Energy (+), and Energy itself is a science. When God says that He "saw ® that it was Good (+)", He is describing his vibe/vibration and sense of Positivity/Positive (+) Energy based on His perception of what was added (+) into existence. Creating (+) and feeling/sensing positivity (+) about it is clear.

It is important to note that God consistently "saw" that it was Good" (+). When God adds (+), He is operating through math, since addition (+) is a clear component of math and is represented by the symbol, +, which is 1 of 4 basic operations of arithmetic. Aside from

addition, the + symbol is also the symbol for Positive *energy* charge, which is the science aspect of the + (ex. a battery has a Positive + and Negative - end).

Taking this analogy a step further, one can conclude that the plus or cross symbol/logo is the race, skin, and visual representation of Addition + and Positivity +. So, this symbol + represents both Addition (+) and Positivity (+). It has a purpose and function relating to both science and math. This exemplifies God's act of creation as addition. Moreover, God's perception or reaction to the addition, is the math and science of the beginning and the invention of the + symbol and its properties. The first operation of arithmetic is Addition + (math), and Positivity + (science). This composes one/third of the image (+) and likeness (Addition, Positive) of God, written in Genesis 1:26.

## Genesis 1:4-1:9



In Genesis 1:4, it states, "And God DIVIDED (÷) the Light from the Darkness." (*Divide means to separate or to make a space between.*) He continues with Genesis 1:6, saying, "Let there be a firmament in the *midst* of the waters, and let it Divide (÷) the waters *from* the waters." Then, in Genesis 1:7, "And God made the firmament and Separated (÷) the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament, and it was so."

Here, we read that God has continued His use of the basic operations of arithmetic. First, there was Addition (+) and its science: the Positive (+). Now, there is Division (÷) and its science to separate (the two dots in the Division symbol represent the digits (digits are Math) and the line in between the dots/digits represents the space between, which acts as the science of the separation of those digits).

This is two thirds of the image ( $\div$ ) and likeness (Division [digits], Separation [space between]) of God, written in Genesis 1:26.

## Genesis 1:9-1:21

(+)

After God concludes with Division, in Genesis 1:9-1:21, He continues with Addition (+), creating/adding (+), "Dry land, and Saw® that it was Good (+). And God (added +) "grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind whose seed is in itself."

God Saw® that it was Good (+), and God added Lights in the firmament to give Light upon the Earth. God then added + (brought into being) every moving creature that hath Life, and Fowl that may fly above the Earth. Again, God added (+) the great whales, and every living creature that moveth and again, God Saw® that it was Good (+).

Now, this is use of the same basic operation of arithmetic. First, the plus/cross as God used, adding (+) the Heaven and the Earth, adding Light into being, and more. Then, God divided and separated things. Afterwards, He started adding (+) again—for good reason.

Genesis 1:22-1:25



Finally,  $^{\text{Genesis }1:22}$  reads, "And God blessed them, saying, be fruitful and  $^{\text{Multiply}}$  ( $\times$ ), and fill the waters in the seas and let fowl  $^{\text{Multiply}}$  in the Earth."

Genesis 1:24 continued, stating, "God said, Let the Earth bring forth the living creature after its kind, cattle, and creeping thing, and every beast of the Earth after his kind: and it was so."

Genesis 1:25 states, "And God made the Beast of the Earth after his kind, and cattle after their kind, and everything that creepeth upon the Earth after his kind: and God saw® that it was Good (+)."

Now, "After its kind" defines the science of Multiplication. To Multiply (×) is to Add (+) more from within. (Notice the symbol for multiplication, ×, is really the symbol for addition, +, simply turned on its side. Thus adding more from within itself, or, of its kind.) Moreover, the alternative terminology for Multiplication in mathematics is 'repeated addition.' So again, we see that God has consistently furthered His use of the basic operations of arithmetic. First, there was

Addition, the math (+) and its science, the Positive (+). Then, there was Division, the math  $(\div)$  and its science of Separation, and now, there is Multiplication, the math  $(\times)$  and its science of addition in motion or repeated addition.

From the beginning, God introduced 3 of the operations of arithmetic in the following order:  $+ + \times$ . This is all three thirds of the *image* ( $\times$ ) and *aikeness* (Multiply, Repeat adding) of God, written in Genesis 1:26.

Through all three operations of arithmetic, God cross-checked the math operation with its science. He added, and expressed positivity (+); He divided, then separated (÷); and lastly, He multiplied and added more from its kind (×). God deliberately invented and introduced to us the basic operations of arithmetic.

Subsequently, immediately after He multiplies, Genesis 1:26 affirms, "God said, Let us make Man in Our image, after Our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the Sea, and over the fowl of the Air, and over the cattle and over all the Earth and over every creeping thing that creepeth over the Earth."

One question that has been posed multiple times, yet remain unanswered in regard to Genesis, is, "What does God mean when he says, 'Let us make man in Our image, after Our likeness'?" God never describes himself. People have always—in some form or another—attempted to define something or someone based on their surface or outer appearance or based on their own perception®. That being said, how can we know His image? It is written, "In our *image*, AFTER our *likeness*." This implies that Man's image is based on God's likeness. So, what is God's *likeness*—or in other words, what is God like? We only know what an individual is like based on how they act, behave, and how operate.

I am reminded of famous quotations and idioms about looking inside of a thing to search for a deeper meaning and to know its true face or true self:

"We judge a man based on the *content* of his character and not by the color of his skin."

"It's not what's on the outside, but what's on the *inside* that counts."

"Don't judge a book by its cover."

"Whenever you want gold, you don't find gold on the surface of the Earth; you've got to go deep down under the surface to get gold. Whenever you want a diamond, you have to go deep down into the Earth to get a diamond. Whenever you want pearls, you have to go deep down into the ocean to find a pearl."

For so long, we've looked to the surface for answers to our deepest questions. What is God like? The answer, for obvious reasons, *must* take place within the first 26 verses of the complete beginning. That is the only evidence we have leading up to the Creation of Man. What can Chapter 1 verse 26 tell us about what God is like? The chapter tells us that God Added things, as we've read from verse 1 to verse 4. It tells us that He then Divided things from verse 4 to verse 8. Next, He Added things like grass, fruit, the sun, the moon, the stars, and more from verse 9 through verse 21. Then, He Multiplied them from verse 22 to verse 25, and He felt Good (+) about it—He had a Positive feeling about each operation. After the last operation, He Multiplied in verse 25. Then in verse 26, He Created Man in the image of what God is like, what God likes to do, what God is likely to do. This is what God is like; He operates in the

exact order of the verse: Added (+) Divided (÷) Added (+) Multiplied (×). Made Man (\*).

These Operations of arithmetic, when abbreviated: A (+) D ( $\div$ ) A (+) M ( $\times$ ), spell A.D.A.M. This is the name God himself gave Man. He created Man in his *image* after what He is *like*, then named him after that likeness.

Note: It has been said that Genesis "is called Genesis because, in the word Genesis, you have the word Gene, the Genetic makeup of 'a thing', a real coding of what a thing will be and what it can be."

The official definition of a gene is; a unit of heredity that is transferred from a parent to offspring and is held to determine some characteristic of the offspring. So, Genesis, as we know it, is the beginning and the birth of existence. In this birth, God Adds (+), Divides ( $\div$ ), Adds (+), then Multiplies ( $\times$ ). Directly after Multiplying, God creates Man in His 'image' and 'likeness'. This is Heredity, which is transferred from a parent (Creator) to offspring (Man) is held to determine characteristics of the offspring (+), ( $\div$ ), (+), ( $\times$ ), which translates (A)(D)(A)(M). Adam was made to till the land, to dress, and to keep it in the way God did, through adding, dividing, adding, and multiplying.



Man (ADAM) was created after what God is *like*, and how God *operates*, and that is demonstrated through three of the four basic operations of arithmetic. Furthermore, the *image* that God speaks of is relative when we apply Marcus Vitruvius' famous drawing, *Vitruvian Man*. This drawing is a mathematical assessment of Man's proportionate measurements studied, sketched, and expounded by famous polymath, Leonardo Da'Vinci, in 1490.

Yet, there are four basic operations of arithmetic. The last, with regard to Vitruvius and Da'vinci, couldn't have been included due to the aim in which Man was being studied. At that time, their study was not about the immaculate design through measurements and proportionate details of the body of Man—the math, Rather, this study addresses the origin and underlying purpose of the design for the body of Man—the science—in both the physical and spiritual aspect.

We should avoid debates centered on science versus religion. Math and science are clearly in the creation of all things and have been present since the first words of the creation of all things. As Albert Einstein stated, "Religion without science is blind®®." There can be no confliction between the two.

Some educational institutions throughout time have used a broken cross  $\perp$  symbol instead of using the + symbol to steer away from writing a symbol that resembles the cross (+). Unbeknownst to them, the cross symbol or image represents the same thing in all three fields. In math: Addition; in science: Positive; in spirit/soul: Christ and the wooden structure He died

on (more on this to come). Other sciences that are found buried in the depths next to the gold, next to diamonds, and beside the pearls are not included.

So, we cannot debunk the existence of God for the sake of science and math, considering the fact that God used math and science to create *all* of existence for our sake. The two existed together. At first, God added things that had never been added before. Then, God had some things and created a space between them, separating them, which had never been done before. Then, God placed inside of some things the ability to create more of itself from within itself to exist on its own outside of itself, which had never been done before.

These actions and operations of math and science exist in what we call the basic operations of arithmetic and are represented by symbols: The + symbol for addition and the science of positive energies; the ÷ symbol for division and the science of separating digits; and the × symbol for multiplication and the science of digits repeat-adding from within themselves. Then, there is the last component of the basic operations of arithmetic, with the symbol (–) for subtraction/absence of, and the science of negative energies. It is important to note that God chose to leave this operation out when creating Man.

Now that we know what Man was created *by*, and what Man was created *with*, we then can identify what Man was created *without*... and why.

Enter the 4th operation.





# One for the Garden, Two for the Grave

"For the day that you eat of it, your Eyes shall be opened..." – The Serpent

"If thine Eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of Light." – Jesus

"And the Lord God formed Man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the Breath of Life; and Man became a Living Soul." - Genesis



Genesis 2:8 states, "The Lord God planted a Garden eastward of E'den; and there He had put the Man whom he had formed. And out of the ground made the Lord God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the **sight**, and good (+) for food; the Tree of Life also in the midst of the Garden, and the Tree of Knowledge of Good (+) and Evil (-)."

The Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil is based on a simple foundation. As mentioned before, Good is essentially a Positive (+) energy and its opposite, Evil, is a Negative (-) energy. This introduces to us the most famous tree in religion: The Fall of Man. How did a simple piece of fruit result in the destruction of Man, the fall, and the outing of a creation made in God's own likeness cast out forever? (That is, lest he takes from the Tree of Life...).

To begin, it is crucial to first address a few important questions: What is this fruit? What are its ingredients? What does it contain that would break the bond between the Creator and his beloved Creation? Was it just simply disobedience, as most lazily claim? If this were the case, it would attribute God to a level of pettiness that could undoubtedly turn humanity against the Creator—if not in ancient times, then surely by now.

Oftentimes, children do things they are told not to do. Banishing a child for a lifetime into the wilderness, never to come home again, is extreme—especially if they were initially made *for* the home. Considering this, when a punishment far exceeds the crime committed, we must ask, "What else could this be about?" "Is there something else to this?" "What am I missing?"

With this Skeleton Key, the A.D.A.M. Operating System, you will recognize that the true reason for Man being cast out isn't a result of God's personal choice of punishment, rather, it was the science of energies, Positive (+) vs Negative (-), Good (+) vs Evil (-).

"But of the Tree of Knowledge of Good (+) and Evil (-), thou shalt not eat of it: for the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die." This is the Book of Genesis, the invention, the beginning of all things. When God says, "Thou shalt surely die," it is the first time that die/death is mentioned, because this is, in fact, 'the beginning.' It would have benefitted A.D.A.M. to have then asked God what the meaning of 'die' is.

Death, as we know it, is the *absence of* Life; it is the opposite of Life, just as the Negative - is the opposite of the Positive +. To fully grasp the definition of Death, one must ask, "What, then, is Life?" This question is answered in the creation of Man. Genesis 2:7 states, "And the Lord God formed Man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the Breath of Life; and Man became a Living Soul."

Life and Living Soul. Life was given to Man by God breathing into Man's nostrils, and Man then became a 'Living Soul'. Then, one can conclude that to Live and to have a Soul is to be connected to God through the breath of God. That being considered, to die, in God's view, means to be soulless, lifeless, and Godless. The 'absence of' is represented by the 4<sup>th</sup> operation of arithmetic, the – symbol. Thus, the Tree of Knowledge of Good (+) and Eyil (-) is essentially the Tree of Knowledge of Positive (+) and Negative (-), or more fittingly, the Tree of Knowledge of Life (+) and Death (-), so the – is the adversary of the +.

It is obvious that God regards Evil (-), Sin (-), Death (-) and Negativity (-) as the same entity; they are the *absence of* Good (+), the *absence of* Life (+) and the *absence of* Positivity (+). God wasn't in an emotional, nor offended state, his ego was *not* the reason for Man being banished from the Garden, as some may believe, painting God the enemy and oppressor to humanity's misunderstanding of freedom; but, God (+) cannot touch Sin (-) as in, a Positive (+) and a Negative (-) cannot occupy the same space.

When God said, "For the day that you eat of the fruit, you shall surely die", it implies that the moment you partake in the Negative (-), you will become opposite of God, the Creator (+), the Adder (+), the Positive (+). It implies that you will be absent of God's breath, which is Life, and anyone absent of Life is Dead. Being absent of God means one is subtracted (-) from God. Essentially, in this instance, God is stating that He and Man are no longer connected through the Liying Soul, which God had given Man, but is now apart, due to Man ingesting the poisonous - substance, or the forbidden fruit of negativity-, which is the Death - of the Liying Soul +, so God and Man cannot be in the same place, amongst each other while the negative (-) is within Man.

The Garden + is a place for the Living Soul +, and the Grave - is a place for the Dead -. Man has defied the Life + and its Garden +, so Man shall be absent from - them. Partaking in the

science of the Negative (-) is the sin, and the wages for sin is death -, or in other words the absence of Life, absent of the Garden, and absent of God.

After the fruit was eaten and Adam and Eve were before God, Eve explains, "The Serpent deceived me, and I did eat."

Note the difference between the use of the word deceived, as opposed to perceive. The root word, De-, is defined as down, away, removal, or reverse. Deconstruction (to tear down) is the opposite/reverse of Construction (to build up). De- represents the lesser version, or opposite of the word it's attached to. To be deceived is equal to having tainted perception or poisoned sight.

In the book, Ye Shall be as Gods, author Erich Fromm writes, "Let us Make man in our image after our likeness...there is no question the emphasis the story puts on this point. It uses two expressions, image & likeness, and it expresses shortly afterward God's fear that Man will become God himself. This fear is 'clearly' stated in Genesis 3:22-23, 'Man has eaten from the Tree of Knowledge, and he has not died, as the serpent correctly predicted; he has become like God. Only mortality distinguishes him from God. The Serpent, who had said, you shall be like Gods, had been right." And lastly, he writes, "As we shall see, the more man 'unfolds' the more he frees himself from God's supremacy, the more he can become like God."

This poses an issue faced in religion and in life itself. The need of Man to compare himself to God or see himself as a challenger to God is problematic in many variations. To *think* or *believe* that God, the Creator of all things, feared or fears Man—His own mini creation— echoes the thoughts and philosophies of history's most Godless men, moreover supremacists, to claim the self to be supreme over all is, in fact, a challenge to God, the known 'Supreme' being. First, with this passage, Erich Fromm slanders, "This fear is clearly stated in Genesis 3:22-23, 'Man has eaten from the Tree of Knowledge and he has not died', as the serpent correctly predicted; he has become as God."

To even comprehend what Death - means and to truly claim that the absence of did not happen, one must first acknowledge the actual title of the Tree in which Death is derived. Fromm says, "Eaten from the Tree of Knowledge and has not died." Fromm is mistaken, as it is called the Tree of Knowledge of Good (+) & Evil (-). One cannot abbreviate the name and simply refer to it as the 'Tree of Knowledge'. This, in itself, aides the slanderers' perception® that God simply attempted to keep Man from attaining knowledge, which is not a Truth +, but rather a Lie -. According to aforementioned explanations, a lie is the absence of the Truth, and uncoincidentally, a tactic used by Godless men in order to attain something of their desires. This is similar to Fromm's perception® where Man accuses God of withholding something of value that would somehow allow the now-Godless Man to usurp or be over and above God in some form.

After acknowledging and comprehending what God regards as Good (positive) and Evil (negative), then God's words, in science, will explain what Death really meant when He warned

of it. Through this understanding, we can identify that Man did, in fact, die by becoming a soulless being (i.e. Godless being, as Godliness is the source of the Living soul).

When I was a youth—a rebellious naysayer of religious things—what I despised most were passages that didn't make sense or appeared to only be included in the text for the sake of being included. One verse in particular in Genesis 2:25 states, "And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were *not ashamed*."

I remember thinking, "Why is that a thing?" I understood that they saw they were naked and weren't ashamed. I thought, "of course, because they didn't have clothes back then so \*shrugs\*, obviously they're naked." What I didn't understand then was that this verse established the most critical event in the history of Biblical Man. The events prior to Genesis 2:25 identified three of the four Operations of Arithmetic, (+÷×). The following segment in the Bible, The Garden of E'den, was to explain the fourth Operation, (-) the absence of. That line in Genesis 2:25 is a bookmark, a holding place for the plot twist, and is the moment in a great story that seems small in Act 1, until it returns soon after in a destructive way as the catalyst for what takes place in Acts 2 and 3. Ultimately every great story has a similar setup. It seems, the 'greatest story ever told' invented it.

Genesis 3:3 states, "But of the fruit of the Tree, which is in the midst of the Garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die." Genesis 3:4 reads, "And the Serpent said unto the woman; Ye shall not surely die." Genesis 3:5 continues, "For God doth know that in the day you eat thereof, then your Eyes® shall be opened, and ye shall be as Gods, knowing Good+ and Evil-." In Genesis 3:6, the woman saw® that the 'Tree was good for food' (it looked® good only after the serpent deceived her that it had positive properties) and that it was pleasant to the Eye®. When the woman realized it was a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit (-) thereof, ate and gave (transferred the sin/death -) unto her husband with her, and He did eat. Their Eyes® were opened, and they felt shame at the sight of their nakedness (selves); and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves aprons (to cover their shamed)."

So, the Man and Woman saw® that they were naked and were *not* ashamed. Then, after they consumed the fruit of the Tree of Knowledge of Good+ and Evil-, they saw® themselves and were ashamed - at the sight® of their nakedness. Genesis 2:25 served as a placeholder to identify where the change happened and what effect the poison fruit/Evil/negative - had on Man. This effect was, in its foundation, Negative - emotion through perception®.

Shame, the feeling Adam and Eve felt, is defined as an unpleasant emotion typically associated with a negative moral or social evaluation caused by the consciousness of self, feelings of distress, mistrust, powerlessness, and worthlessness. Other definitions include to publicly humiliate, or to disgrace. This is the first time a negative emotion is not only felt but explained in the scripture. Each part

where God creates, the scripture ends with, 'and God saw® that it was Good,' 7 times, specifically Genesis 1:31, "And God saw everything that he had made, and, behold, it was very good." There is emphasis placed on 'good'. We know that 'Good' is, a Positive +. There was never a mention of God, Man, Plant or Animal feeling a Negative - energy or emotion.

What the fruit of the Tree of Knowledge of Good + and Evil - did was negatively - impact both Man and Woman's Perspectives® from seeing® things as they are, good +, as God created them, to seeing things in a negative- way (race hatred®). The Human Body and how it looks was not a concern until after the fruit - was consumed. The effects of the Evil - are only mentioned or effective through perception®: They saw ® that they were naked and were not ashamed. After all, this is related to what the Serpent told Eve: "For God doth know that the day you eat thereof, your eyes ® shall be opened, and you shall be as God's, knowing Good + and Evil -." (Knowing Positive AND Negative. Meaning they ONLY knew Positive prior to.) If their eyes ® were opened after eating the fruit, then how did they See® before this? Perhaps it was the same Eye® that God has ®, the 1st Eye ®, most incorrectly referred to as the 'third' eye ® (which itself is the key link to certain mysteries).

The Pineal Gland, which allows one to See and experience an alternate perspective of existence through a single sensory Eye is tucked in the center, between the right and left brain: "If thine eye be single thy whole body shall be full of light." This gland has eye tissue within it and is extremely sensitive to light, producing serotonin and melatonin-derived signaling of molecules that are responsible for the system of images, ideas, emotions, and sensations during 'sleep' (when the 'flesh eyes' are closed).

When the Serpent told Adam and Eve that their Eyes would be opened after eating the fruit -, the Serpent was referring to the flesh eyes opening up and condemning Man to only seeing things through and by the flesh which will be used to act out/operate by negativity.

This essentially cut Man off from God and the third 15th eye. Man now saw things through the flesh body and eyes. Man began to think that this change made them their own Gods, a flesh God-, capable of negativity- being opposite of God the Spirit +.

Now, Man has the ability to see things with a negative perspective. This is an after-effect of the fruit, for Man had already known Good +. God, of course, already knows Good +; it is the Evil - that God wanted to protect Man from, simply because Man /ADAM wasn't built with the Negative (-) gene or Operation. (We see that the fruit infected their offspring also, with Cain (-) and Abel (+). It was all that followed after eating the fruit, negative; man feeling fear at Gods voice, hiding, blaming the woman, etc., followed by punishment after punishment; unbearable pains and multiplied sorrows, heels bruising heads, sweat pouring from the brows, and all these punishments are flesh related).

Created through three of the four operations of arithmetic  $(+, \div, +, \text{ and } \times)$ , the Negative (-) should be a foreign attribute to God's Man, who was given Dominion over every Living thing

upon the Earth, that which God's Man/Woman was put here to replenish and subdue. It was not for those who turned from God and proudly embrace the negative - and its effects-. Remember, God gave the Earth to Man, whom he made in his image and likeness, specifically for dressing and keeping the Earth. Genesis 2:5 states, "And every plant of the field before it was in the Earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the Lord God had not caused it to rain upon the Earth, and there was not a Man to till the ground." Then God waters the ground. Genesis 2:7 adds, "And the Lord God formed Man of the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of Life; And Man became a Living Soul. 8 And the Lord God planted a Garden eastward in E'den; and there he put the Man whom he had formed." Genesis 2:15 continues this, stating, "And the Lord God took the Man and put him into the Garden of E'den to dress and to keep it."

God built Man; He made Man in His image to take care of His work. God would not have given the Earth to someone or something less than capable, less than equipped, less than responsible, or less than Himself. He would not have given the Earth to someone or something that was opposite or absent of Him. He wouldn't have given the Earth to someone to destroy, pillage, or plunder its resources, or to slaughter and oppress its living beings—Man, plant and animal alike. These are Godless acts that go against God's intentions and purpose for Man, the fowl of the Air, the creature of the Sea, and every living thing that creeps upon the Earth.

The destruction and desolation of Life and God's creations are scientifically and spiritually absent of — God/Life. Yet, operations of the absence of — can't be carried out by themselves.

Absence of — is carried out by those who are absent of God themselves. Their Science and purpose, their actions, or their modus operandi are opposite of God's, as Gods purpose and intentions are for the Living+, those for anything other than Life+ and the Living+ (addition, creation, +) are for Death— and the Dead— (subtraction, destruction, —). Perception through the Single Eye

Third Eye (love, care, freedom, truth) is of the Garden (life/living), Deception through the 2

Flesh Eyes — Negative Perception (hate, abuse, oppression, lies) are of the Graye (death/dead). 'For the day that you eat (partake) of the fruit (negative —), ye will surely die (—).'
