

GLA Weed/Algae/Sediment Control Committee Report

(May 20th , 2019 GLA Board Meeting)

Rollin's Aquatic Solutions was on-site inspecting our lakes for problematic weed & algae growth twice during the first 20 days of May. A recap of the on-site visits are as follows:

Wednesday 5/8/19

Goose Lake – Was unable to visit Goose Lake due to bad weather. Next on-site visit will be on 5/15/19.

Beaver Lake – Lake Level +8.5 inches – 57 degrees F – 9.1 mg/L oxygen content
Performed spot treatment of 1.85 acres for Curly Leaf Pondweed in north section of Half-Moon which was delayed 1 week due to storms and excessive rains. Inspected the entire lake. Noted a moderate amount of Curly Leaf Pondweed and Milfoil growth in areas on the north end of Beaver Lake. Will continue to monitor. No treatments scheduled for next site visit on 5/15/19.

Lincoln Lake – Was unable to visit Lincoln Lake due to bad weather. Next on-site visit will be on 5/15/19.

Wednesday 5/15/19

Goose Lake – Lake Level +6.0 inches – 61 degrees F – 8.45 mg/L oxygen content
Inspected the entire lake and found a few areas needing attention. Noted 3 areas throughout the lake totaling 2.0 acres needing spot treatment for Curly Leaf Pondweed, Milfoil, and Filamentous Algae. Water Usage Restriction Notices will be sent out to those affected property owners for scheduled treatment on 5/22/19.

Beaver Lake – Lake Level +7.5 inches – 60 degrees F – 8.51 mg/L oxygen content
Inspected the entire lake and found a few areas needing attention. Noted 4 areas throughout the lake totaling 4.5 acres needing spot treatments for Curly Leaf Pondweed, Milfoil, and Chara type Algae. Water Usage Restriction Notices will be sent out to those affected property owners for scheduled treatment on 5/22/19.

Lincoln Lake – Lake Level +7.0 inches – 59 degrees F – 9.02 mg/L oxygen content
Inspected the entire lake and found a few areas needing attention. Noted 5 areas throughout the lake totaling 1.6 acres needing spot treatments for Curly Leaf pondweed, Milfoil, and Chara type Algae. Water Usage Restriction Notices will be sent out to those affected property owners for scheduled treatment on 5/22/19.

Next Rollins on-site visit scheduled for 5/22/19 with a rain date of 5/23/19.
