Current Rule

(a) Watercraft equipped with inboard rear V-drive engines or equipped with any wake or wake enhancing devices such as, but not limited to ballast tanks,

Proposed Rule Change

(a) Watercraft equipped with inboard rear engines INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO V-Drive BOATS, INBOARD/OUTBOARD BOATS AND JET BOATS, or BOATS THAT ARE equipped with any wake or wake exhanncing devices such as but not limited to ballast tanks, hydro gates, etc.

Section 6.2: BOATING AND USEAGE

Current Rule

(f) Pontoon Boats are limited to pull a single tube, only in a straight-line fashion allowing for turns following the contours of the lake. WATER SKIING AND KNEE BOARDING IS NOT PERMITTED BEHIND PONTOON BOATS.

Proposed Rule Change

(f) Pontoon Boats are limited to pull a single tube AT NO WAKE SPEED only Pulling in a straight-line fashion allowing for turns following the contours of the lake. WATER SKIING AND KNEE BOARDING IS NOT PERMITTED BEHIND PPONTOON BOATS.

SECTION 6.6: NUMBER OF ALLOWED WATERCRAFT
No more than seven (7) watercraft units are allowed per member, of which no more
than a total of four (4) watercraft units can be motorized (motorized includes

 - (b) The max number of PWC's (Jet Skis) allowed is 100.
