# Motion by Chris Figge and seconded by Mike Poeschel to accept Treasurer's Report subject to audit. Motion carried unanimously.

Jim Krebaum set a date for an Audit to take place 4.March.2015. He asked for another board volunteer.

**Campground** – Terry Kapinus discussed the length of campers on the campground. This would require a **\*RULES** change. Paul noted the length and weight cause ruts in the campground. There is an average of 40-50 campers per season. He noted that 35' should be the maximum for this small campground.

# Motion by Mike Poeschel and seconded by Terry Kapinus to limit the length of campers to 36'. Current campers will be grandfathered. Motion defeated.

Terry Kapinus discussed Joe Turk's open membership drive. The committee has not met to discuss it.

Terry reported purchasing a 2001 Ford F250 for \$9800. With fees and taxes the amount was just over \$10,000.

Terry Kapinus discussed the length of campers on the campground. The rules have no length limit. Discussion followed and recommendations from the Campground Committee were sought for the next meeting.

**Sheriff's Report-** Deputy Black reviewed his report and discussion followed addressing concerns for the area. An eblast will be sent concerning the thefts in the area.

**Maintenance** – Jim Arnold doing the monthly check of the dam. The brush has been trimmed near the dam.

Social – Terry Gomien reported the Easter Egg Hunt would take place on April 4th.

Marinas – Chris Figge reported the lake levels.

Tom Sula discussed the current financial certificates of deposit held by GLA and other investment options to earn interest. Jim clarified banking resolutions. He discussed total cash positions since January 1997.
