Motion by Dick Reichman and seconded by Mike Poeschel to accept the 30.Mar.2015 Minutes as corrected. Motion passed unanimously.

Beach – Tom Morris reported that the beach will be ready to open on Memorial Day weekend. Applications are now being accepted for lifeguard positions.

Maintenance – Jim Arnold reported that the Beaver Lake playground and baseball field are ready for use.

Dam – Jim Arnold reported that dam maintenance had been performed.

Weeds – Tony reviewed his report noting McCloud had visited all three lakes. The finger channels and the main east/west channel of Goose Lake were treated with Copper Sulfate. Tom Morris was thanked for alerting the board of this weed problem on Goose Lake. Lake temps were 54 on Lincoln and 59 on Goose and Beaver. McCloud will be back on 4/28.

Tony reported attending the Lincoln Lake Estates annual meeting. They approved sharing in the cost of weeds (\$893) and fish (\$500) but not safety patrol.

Shoreline – Chris Figge reported issuing new shoreline permits. Any shoreline work requires a permit.

Marinas – Chris Figge reported the lake levels. Joe Turk noted that the levels on the lake gauges don't match the actual measured levels of the lakes. Joe reported actual April measured readings for the lakes. LL 3.75" BL 5.75" GL4.5"
