Beach – Tom Morris noted the beach will open over the Memorial Day weekend. Motion by Tom Morris and seconded by Dick Reichman for \$1200 to replace 2 lifeguard chairs. Money is in the budget. Motion Carried unanimously

Maintenance – Jim Arnold noted that the dam plate went in on Beaver Lake. They are dressing up Beaver Lake park.
