Beach- Carpeted all three ramps, Painted shower house, working on sand, working on women's side. Tom Sula asked why roof vents where not put in to prevent moisture, Mike Poeschel explained how venting was done.

Maintenance-Bought a trailer load of field mix for ballfield, received an invoice for lights Fixed lights labor cost \$666.00 Jim Arnold asked for funds to be passed Steve Anderson made a motion to accept labor cost seconded by Tom Sula vote was unanimous.
