The royal blue matches the ensign of the Royal Navy's Blue Squadron. The red stars symbolize the country's geographical location in the southern hemisphere. They also pay homage to ancient Maori mythology. As recently as 2016, New Zealand citizens could vote between the current flag design and a new one featuring their iconic silver fern - but the original won and remains the national standard to this day. 14.
