**State Testing:** Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCAs) are taken by our 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students. Please make sure your child is well rested so they can do their best on these state tests. MCA dates:

MCA Reading: Tuesday and Wednesday, April 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. MCA Math: Tuesday and Wednesday, April 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>.

MCA Science (5<sup>th</sup> grade only): Wednesday and Thursday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>.
