We launched WATCHDOGS at Elm Creek in 2019 and are excited to bring it back each year. Our first WATCHD.O.G.S. day at Elm Creek will be Friday, January 26<sup>th</sup>. We will have a group of men (EC dads, stepdads, grandpas, uncles etc.) come to the school and help out in different classrooms. It's always a fun day, and the students love seeing the WATCHD.O.G.S. in the building!

We are fortunate to have four Elm Creek volunteers leading Art Adventure this year. They completed training at MIA and are busy preparing lessons and projects for each grade level. They will go into classrooms and present throughout the month of February. Our 3<sup>rd</sup> graders will receive an extra art lesson in working with clay from local volunteer artist, Barbara Aldaffer. Barbara visits 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classrooms in February to teach them how to make clay pots. It's going to be a creative month at Elm Creek!

**Student Council:** We collected 650 pounds of food for CROSS. For our next service project we are making valentine cards for residents at Havenwood retirement center in Maple Grove. Student Council members are continuing to make positive message signs to post around the school as well as collecting markers for recycling.

**Kindergarten News:** Kindergarteners at Elm Creek Elementary School were recently visited by Maple Grove firefighters. The students watched a video on the ABCs of fire safety, played "safe to play or stay away," learned about how to make a plan in the case of a fire, and heard what a fire alarm sounds like. The firefighters also demonstrated the equipment that they wear while fighting fires. At the end, the kindergarteners had the opportunity to ask questions, such as where the axe and hose are stored and if they have a fire dog.
