WATCH D.O.G.S. (Dads of Great Students) is a powerful, national program that seeks to involve male role models in schools through active participation. We launched WATCHDOGS at Elm Creek in 2019 and are excited to bring it back each year. We had our first WATCH D.O.G.S. day at Elm Creek on Thursday, January 8th. We had a group of 3 EC dads and one retired community volunteer come to the school and help in different classrooms. It was a fun day, and the students loved seeing the WATCH D.O.G.S. in the building! Our next WATCHDOGS day will be Wednesday, February 11th.

ART ADVENTURE WITH Minneapolis Institute of Art (MIA)—Art Adventure begins in February, offering an exciting art curriculum for our students based around the theme “How People Lived.” We are fortunate to have five returning Elm Creek volunteers leading Art Adventure again this year. They completed training at MIA and are busy preparing lessons and projects for each grade level. They will go into classrooms and present throughout the month of February. Our 3rd graders will receive an extra art lesson in working with clay from local volunteer artist, Barbara Aldaffer. Barbara visits 3rd grade classrooms in February to teach them how to make clay pots. It’s going to be a creative month at Elm Creek!

Conferences and Book Fair: Winter Conferences will be on March 3rd, March 5th and March 11th, both before and after school. Scheduling information will be coming out next month.

Seussical Kids Musical: Stages Theatre is offering a community education after school opportunity for Elm Creek Elementary students. Students enrolled in this class will be performing *Seussical Kids Musical* on **Friday, March 13th at 7 p.m. and Saturday, March 14th at 2 p.m.**, at Maple Grove Middle School. Admission is FREE and the show is about 1 hour long.

Coffee with the Principal: I like to connect with families in several ways to gather feedback and be available to answer questions. One way is through *Coffee with the principal*. K through 2nd grade students will get started on beginning research and information seeking skills like using PebbleGo.
