Kindergarten Highlights: In kindergarten we are busy learning about our five senses and exploring how important they are to our everyday lives. Now that the weather is getting cooler, we are getting lots of practice putting on our winter gear for our two recesses. We are working hard during our phonics time and on our way to becoming readers!

Fourth Grade Highlights: 4th Grade is in the middle of five weeks of our DARE program. We are learning valuable lessons about making good choices and being kind to others. In November we took a field trip to Feed My Starving Children. We packed 97 boxes which is 20,952 meals, which will feed 57 kids for a whole year! On December 10th we will be going to Eastman Nature Center for a class on Wilderness Survival. This ties very well in with the novel Hatchet by Gary Paulsen.

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Birthday Lunches: One day at the end of each month, a table is set up in the lunchroom. Students who have their birthday during that month can have lunch with the principal and will get ice cream. Students who have birthdays in July and August will celebrate in June. Our November birthday lunches will be on Monday, November 25th.
