Goal is to read at least at least 15 minutes a day. Options included for those that don't have internet access. Teachers also get logins to see their students and encourage student reading. No up front payment needed. 70/30% split with 30% going to the platform and 70% going back to Elm Creek PTO. Volunteer Eagles needed to participate in classroom. Incentives include weekly grab bags, medal award ceremony, a Principal challenge.

Requirement for teachers? Some teachers distributing materials and reminding students to read 15 min daily. Teachers may or may not login to the site. Platform would be for the entire school/all grades and classrooms. Suggestion to turn off comments on site or maybe have the teachers be able to approve. Thursday April 3 is Family Reading night which is focused on grades K-2. Possibility of combining award ceremony with Family Reading night but maybe another night specifically for 3rd-5th grades. Students can get pledges by minutes read or a flat rate. Students can still participate if no funds are donated.
