

President Report April 16th 2024

- Criminal Case
 - I contacted Detective Wareham Monday April 1st and Wednesday April 10th. The case is still in review with the Hennepin County District Attorney's office. On Wednesday the detective gave me an email for the Citizen Information at the HCAO, he said they might be able to see a status report.
 - On Friday 4/12 3:30 pm I received an email from the HCAO advocate that will be our go-between for the DA office. She let me know that the HCAO financial analyst is still reviewing all the evidence we had provided to the HCAO, they are hoping to have it ready in a couple months.
 - I had discussed with the detective and our advocate that in July we will be handing over the PTO title and responsibilities. HCAO stated since myself, Renae and Kathleen filed the charges on behalf of the PTO and the outcry statement was made to us directly we would still be the main point of contact. If this did end up in the media myself and Bao would be the ones giving statements.
