Legislature Update by Dave Shaffer

- S399 – Pistols – Glocks easily manipulated – looking to do away with them in NYS
- S4277 – 50 cal rifles – extreme amount of poorly written language in this bill that will add on more shotguns/rifles. Person pushing it is not running for re-election.
- S5974 - New Jersey – million-dollar insurance policy, 1,000,000 requirement – NYS wants to add this. No current insurance companies in NYS that would cover this.
- S362 – firearm purchase – need to wait 10 days to get it.
- A360 – own or purchase a firearm – required to see a state professional for mental stability.

State Meeting update from Matt Thorton

- Bill to affect the youth. Trying to make it so no one under the age of 21 cannot possess a firearm. Will severely hurt youth hunting.

Upstate New Yorks need to go vote. Call senators/legislators, etc. to appeal these bills.
