The execution of this successful event incurred a **total expenditure of approximately \$4,012.** This encompassed various aspects such as catering, decor, the raffle item (tablet), prints, banners, and other essential event-related expenses. The meticulous allocation of resources contributed to the overall effectiveness and impact of the occasion.

2.5 Net Income:

The net income for the entire event, calculated by deducting expenses from the total revenue, **stands at a positive \$57,871.00.** This remarkable outcome underscores the financial success and effectiveness of the fundraiser in achieving its goals.
