

TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Council of Mitchell, Georgia, was called to order by Mayor Scott Lamb, on Monday, January 14, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall.

Mayor Lamb rendered the invocation. Following the reading of the minutes of the last regularly scheduled meeting, held December 10, 2018, Lewis Berry made the recommendation to amend the document, including additional work agreed upon for LMIG's 2019 project. Jacky Haywood made the motion to approve the amendment to the minutes; Allen Underwood second the motion. Motion carried.

LMIG 2019

Mayor Lamb informed the council of the completion of the LMIG project, including the sediment removal and reconstruction of the cut-thru between GA HWY 102 W and Warren Street, and cleaning of drains on Washington, Warren, Jefferson, and Main Streets. The council agreed to pay Larry Norris Construction, Inc. using T-SPLOST funds, with the intention of reimbursing the account with 2019 LMIG funds, minus the required 10% match.

CEMETERY

After discussion regarding the layout of unused land in Mitchell's cemetery, Mayor Lamb requested Lewis Berry design a plan for the new cemetery addition, complete with plots and space for thoroughfares.

COMMUNITY HOUSE DAMAGE

Mitchell's council members analyzed photographs of wall damage that occurred during an event on January 12, 2019. After discussion, the council agreed to withhold the \$50.00 deposit to repair the damaged wall. The council decided to contact Teddy Cooper to assess and fix the wall and broken steps on the back porch.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, Lewis Berry made the motion to adjourn, second by Jacky Haywood. Motion carried, and the meeting recessed at 7:35 p.m.
