

TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Council of Mitchell, Georgia, was called to order by Mayor Scott Lamb, on Monday, November 11, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall.

Mayor Pro tem Berry rendered the invocation. Following the reading of the minutes of the last regularly scheduled meeting held on October 14, 2019, Councilman Underwood made the motion to approve the minutes; Mayor Pro tem Berry second the motion. Motion carried.

OTHER

Council Notification/Approval of Town Events

Mayor Lamb expressed concern of the council not being aware of a community yard sale held in Mitchell. Councilman Haywood made the motion to require the council to approve all town events; Councilman Underwood second the motion. With no opposition, motion carried.

Landscaping Contract

Mayor Pro tem Berry and Clerk Simmons offered a drafted Request for Proposals (RFP) for potential landscapers to utilize if making a bid on the 2020-2022 landscaping contract. Councilman Landrum made the motion to approve the RFP and advertise the proposal in the town's legal organ. Mayor Pro tem Berry second the motion. With no opposition, motion carried.

Opioid Class Action Litigation

Clerk Simmons explained that after notifying the town's attorney of the decision to opt-out, the attorney recommended the town stay in the Opioid Class Action Litigation. Councilman Haywood made the motion to continue in the litigation, Councilman Landrum second the motion. With no opposition, motion carried.

Statewide Mutual Aid & Assistance Agreement

Clerk Simmons offered the statewide mutual aid and assistance agreement to the council, per the request of Mike Lyons, Glascock County's EMA Director.

FY19 Budget Amendment/FY20 Budget

The council reviewed both the town's revised Fiscal Year 19 and the proposed Fiscal Year 20 Budgets. Clerk Simmons stated the public would have the opportunity to be heard on the FY20 Budget during the December council meeting. Councilman Underwood made the motion to approve the FY19 Budget Amendment; Mayor Pro tem Berry second the motion. With no opposition, motion carried.

LMIG 2020

After reviewing financial options, the council voted to approve spending the required 10% match for the LMIG 2020 project. If deemed necessary, they will revisit the financials when discussing bids during the December meeting. Councilman Landrum made the motion for the approval; Councilman Haywood second the motion. With no opposition, motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, Mayor Pro tem Berry made the motion to adjourn, second by Councilman Landrum. Motion carried, and the meeting adjourned at 7:55 p.m.
