

## TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Council of Mitchell, Georgia, was called to order by Mayor Scott Lamb, on Monday, December 10, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall.

### **LMIG 2020**

#### Opening of Sealed Bids for RFP 2019-001

Mayor Lamb acknowledged the reception of two (2) sealed bids for the 2020 LMIG Tree Project. AGM Services presented a bid in the amount of \$3,200-\$3,500. Elite Tree Care offered to complete the project for \$12,825.00. Councilman Haywood made a motion to accept the bid from AGM Services; Councilman Landrum second the motion. With no oppositions, motion carried.

### **Fire Department**

#### Washington EMC Grant

Clerk Simmons informed the council that Fire Chief Landrum received a grant from Washington EMC for almost \$3,000 for fire department equipment.

**Other**

FY20 Budget

Clerk Simmons presented the FY20 Budget. After review, Councilman Landrum made the motion to approve the budget; Mayor Pro tem Berry second the motion. With no oppositions, motion carried.

Light on Main Street

Mayor Lamb informed the council of destruction to the light on the corner of Main and Washington Streets. A truck driver misjudged the distance required to turn onto Washington Street and knocked the lamp post over, destroying the unit. Although the driver of the vehicle left the scene of the accident, feedback from the town's camera system permitted easy identification of the company in which the truck originated. The town will forward all bills for replacement of the light to the company, who agrees to handle damages.

Cemetery Fund

Clerk Simmons informed the council of efforts to collect contributions towards Mitchell's cemetery fund. Simmons reported that, to date, the town received \$550.
