

TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Council of Mitchell, Georgia, was called to order by Mayor Scott Lamb, on Monday, May 14, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall.

Lewis Berry rendered the invocation. Following the reading of the minutes of the last regularly scheduled meeting, motion made by Allen Underwood second by Lewis Berry, to approve the minutes of the April 9, 2018, regular monthly meeting. Motion carried.

WATER DEPARTMENT

- Clerk Sara Simmons informed the council that the insurance company paid the claim in full, for the storm damage at the well on HWY 123.
- Clerk Simmons provided each council member a copy of the 2017 Water Quality Report, informing them that the report was also available on the town's website.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

- Mayor Lamb informed the council that there are two new firemen joining Mitchell's volunteer department; they will need radios. Lewis Berry made the motion to purchase the two radios; Alan Landrum second the motion.

PARK

- Mayor Lamb updated the council regarding destruction and removal of signs in the park. Clerk Simmons informed the council that she spoke with Sheriff Jeremy Kelley to create a plan for surveillance. The council agreed to proceed with partnering with Sheriff Kelley to ensure safety and minimize damage.

OTHER

- Clerk Simmons notified the council of complaints of animals roaming on private properties.
- Mayor Lamb updated the council on the conditions of the community house and ball field. He noted that a team from the Glascock County Rec Department practices on the field, which is in disrepair. Additionally, the community house could use updating. Lewis Berry offered to contact County Commissioner Lori Boyen about a previously promised backstop for the ballfield. Mayor Lamb stated he would seek quotes on flooring for the community house floor.
- Clerk Simmons provided the council members, Mrs. Berry, and Chief Landrum a copy of the 2018 Springfest financials and informed the council that the next festival will occur April 26, 27, 28, 2019.
