The regular monthly meeting of the Town Council of Mitchell, Georgia, was called to order by Mayor Scott Lamb, on Monday, March 11, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall.

Following the reading of the minutes of the last regularly scheduled meeting, held February 11, 2019 and the called meeting held February 21, 2019, Lewis Berry made the motion to approve the minutes from both meetings; Jacky Haywood second the motion. WATER DEPARTMENT

Clerk Simmons notified the council of a September 2018 water system violation. Simmons explained the town would notify all residents by direct mail and the Jefferson Reporter.

Mayor Lamb informed the council of a mechanical malfunction of the HWY 123 well. The mayor explained a plan is in the works with Metro Water to resolve the issue.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Per Fire Chief Landrum's February request, the council discussed several options for the purchase of a camera system, for installation on Mitchell's City Hall & Fire building. Alan Landrum made the motion to purchase a 12-camera system, complete with a 4TB hard drive for \$1,099.00 from Sam's Club. The town will use SPLOST III funds to finance the purchase. Allen Underwood second the motion. With no oppositions, motion carried.

CEMETERY

Clerk Simmons provided the council members with a proposed ordinance for the cemetery, setting forth an array of provisions, guidelines, and stipulations. Jacky Haywood made the motion to approve the Authority of the Town to Regulate the Cemetery. Lewis Berry second the motion. As there were no oppositions, motion carried.

OTHER

Clerk Simmons informed the council that she requested quotes from various vendors for the treatment of ants on city property and mosquitoes throughout the town.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, Alan Landrum made the motion to adjourn; second by Lewis Berry. Motion carried, and the meeting recessed at 7:45 p.m.
