

TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES

The regular monthly meeting of the Town Council of Mitchell, Georgia, was called to order by Mayor Scott Lamb, on Monday, July 8, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall.

Mayor Pro tem Berry rendered the invocation. Following the reading of the minutes of the last regularly scheduled meeting held June 17, 2019, and called meeting held July 1, 2019, Councilman Haywood made the motion to approve the minutes of both meetings; Councilman Underwood second the motion. Motion carried.

OTHER

Mitchell's Walking Track

Regarding repaving the portion of Mitchell's Walking Track that lay on private property, Mayor Lamb presented a written quote from Johnnie Smith's Paving Company for \$2,000. Clerk Simmons informed the council that she contacted three other companies for bid amounts but was unable to obtain a dollar figure. Councilman Landrum indicated he would break the track apart; Mayor Lamb stated he would use a forklift to remove the broken materials. Once complete, the contractor would lay a new portion of track on Mitchell property. Councilman Landrum made a motion to approve Johnnie Smith's Paving Company to lay the new track; Mayor Pro tem Berry second the motion. With no oppositions, motion carried.

2019 Tax Mill Rate

Clerk Simmons presented the current proposed 2019 Tax Digest and Five Year History of Levy to the council. The council shall reconvene in the August meeting to vote on the proposed Mill Rate.

LMIG 2020

Clerk Simmons gave the council initial Georgia DOT information for the 2020 LMIG project.

Mitchell's 2020 Comprehensive Plan

Clerk Simmons related the CSRA Regional Commission requested the council vote on at least one representative from the council to assist in Mitchell's 2020 Comprehensive Plan. Councilman Landrum made the motion to recommend Mayor Pro tem Berry and Councilman Underwood represent the city in plan updating. Councilman Haywood second the motion. With no oppositions, motion carried.
