Lewis Berry rendered the invocation. Following the reading of the minutes of the last regularly scheduled meeting on August 14, 2023, Lisa Raley motioned to approve the minutes; Allen Underwood voiced a second to the motion. Motion carried.

Mill Rate

Motion made by Lewis Berry, second by Allen Underwood, to approve a net millage rate of 5.631 for the 2023 property taxes. Motion carried.

Water Department

Washington Street Well: Mayor Berry reported that the antennae had been replaced on the Washington Street well and the well is working properly.


Pulliam Lumber Company: Mayor Berry noted that Pulliam Lumber Company had drilled a well for their facility's treatment process and had gone offline for town water service. She noted this action would impact revenue, but should also reduce chemical and power costs for the town.

Election Update

Mayor Berry noted the town would not hold a general election on November 7, 2023, as only three (3) candidates had qualified for the three (3) expiring seats. Shelby Borton, Lisa Raley, and Amy Wallace were unopposed; therefore, no election is necessary.
