

TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
Called Meeting July 1, 2019

Mayor Pro Tem Lewis Berry made the motion to exit Executive Session; Counselman Clay Walden second the motion. Motion carried.


POSITION OF MITCHELL'S WALKING TRACK

Through a public telephone conference, Attorney Chris Dube advised he thought it was within the council's best interest to settle the matter of the position of the walking track that currently lay on private property. The attorney suggested the council vote on seeking the cheapest option. The council heard commentary and varying financial quotes from Public Attendee Anthony Griswell, owner of the property on which the track lay. The council discussed the various options for settling the matter, including purchasing a portion of the track-containing property from Mr. Griswell. Additionally, Mayor Lamb stated he received a proposal in which contractor Johnnie Smith Paving (same contractor who lay the original track) indicated he would move the track for a figure estimated around \$1,500 to \$2,000.

Mayor Lamb made the motion to request a formal bid from Johnnie Smith to relocate the track. Councilman Clay Walden second the motion.

Councilman Clay Walden made a motion to adjourn; Alan Landrum second the motion. Meeting adjourned at 5:30 p.m.
