**APPROVAL TO SELL FIRE TRUCK**


Chief Landrum informed the council of the intent of the Glascock County Fire Department/City of Gibson to purchase Mitchell's 1976 Duplex-Pierce Engine for an estimated \$10,000. Jacky Haywood made the motion to approve the sale, second by Alan Landrum. With no oppositions, motion carried.

**APPROVAL TO PURCHASE FIRE TRUCK**

Mayor Lamb, Councilman Landrum, and Chief Landrum told of their visit to Greensboro, to examine a 1996 E-One Pumper truck. With all inspecting parties satisfied, the fire chief requested the purchase of this vehicle. Chief Landrum stated the city could use \$5,000.00 from the firemen's fundraiser account. Mayor Lamb notified of the intent to request an additional \$5,000.00 from the Mitchell Springfest committee. Clerk Simmons provided a statement of the city's investment pool funds, stating that the account could finance the transaction. Jacky Haywood made the motion to approve the purchase of Engine 903 for \$35,000.00, using the funds from the city's investment savings account. Alan Landrum second the motion. With no oppositions, motion carried.
