VP's Accomplishments

- Tackling the Big Banks: Delivered \$20 billion in relief for middle-class families
- Homeowner Protections: Helped pass one of the nation's first Homeowner Bill of Rights.

Moving Forward and Building an Opportunity Economy

- Reducing Costs: Focus on lowering the cost of health care, housing, and groceries.
- Supporting Small Businesses: Increased access to capital for small-business owners, entrepreneurs, and founders, facilitating over \$1.7 billion in grants to more than 600 CDFIs nationwide.
- Addressing the Housing Crisis: Proposing the construction of 3 million new housing units to end America's housing shortage.
- Protecting Social Safety Nets: Committed to protecting Social Security and Medicare.
- Restoring Rights: Pledge to sign bills restoring reproductive freedom, passing the John Lewis Voting Rights Act and the Freedom to Vote Act.
- Comprehensive Immigration Reform: Support signing a bipartisan border security bill, offering an earned pathway to citizenship while securing the border.
- Middle-Class Tax Relief: Advocate for a middle-class tax cut that will benefit over 100 million Americans.

Contrast with Trump and Republicans

- Social Safety Nets: Trump/Republicans propose cutting Social Security and Medicare.
- Healthcare: Plans to dismantle the Affordable Care Act.
- Education: Propose eliminating the Department of Education and endangering public school funding.
- Early Childhood Programs: Aim to end programs like Head Start, which provide preschool and child care.
- Taxation: Trump's tariff plan creates what amounts to a national sales tax that would raise costs for middle-class families by nearly \$4,000 a year.
- Reproductive Rights: Seek to limit access to birth control, ban medication abortion, and enact a nationwide abortion ban
- Surveillance of Women: Create a national anti-abortion coordinator, forcing states to report on women's miscarriages and abortions.
