

## Top 20 Things to Know about Kamala Harris's record as Vice President

- **1.** Vice President Harris has held hundreds of events since her swearing-in.
- **2.** In 2024, Vice President Harris visited 20 states and made multiple trips to 14 states, totaling over 60 trips to communities across America.
- **3.** Vice President Harris has led both domestically and internationally with trips to Ghana, Tanzania, Zambia, Germany, The Bahamas, Indonesia, the UAE for COP28, and the United Kingdom for the first-ever Global AI Summit.
- **4.** She has represented the United States in 20 countries over 15 different foreign trips.
- **5.** Vice President Harris has met with more than 150 world leaders to strengthen America's alliances.
- **6.** She leads the administration's efforts on maternal health, resulting in 47 states plus DC expanding post-partum Medicaid coverage from 60 days to 12 months, and the launch of the National Maternal Mental Health Hotline, which has connected nearly 38,000 individuals to free confidential, 24/7 support. Harris was the first to introduce a Senate bill addressing Black maternal mortality (Maternal CARE Act) and proposed funding for uterine fibroid research, affecting over 80% of Black women.
- **7.** As Chair of the White House Task Force on Worker Organizing and Empowerment, Harris mobilizes federal policies, programs, and practices to empower workers to organize and successfully bargain with their employers.
- **8.** Harris chairs the National Space Council, advising and assisting the President on space policy and strategy.
- **9.** She oversees the first-ever White House Office of Gun Violence Prevention, which advocates for commonsense gun safety laws at the state and federal levels.
- **10.** Leading the administration's response to reproductive rights under assault, Harris has led over 50 convenings in at least 16 states and embarked on a Reproductive Freedoms tour.

- **11.** She leads the administration's efforts to eradicate lead pipes over the next decade.
- **12.** Harris spearheads efforts to reduce medical debt, aiming to remove it from the credit reports of over 15 million Americans.
- **13.** She leads the administration's efforts to reduce homeownership appraisal bias.
- **14.** Leveraging funding secured during her Senate tenure, Harris has facilitated the Treasury's awarding of over \$1.7 billion in grants to more than 600 Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFIs) nationwide.
- **15.** Harris leads efforts to expand broadband access, enabling 19 million Americans to enroll in the Affordable Connectivity Program for discounted internet access.
- **16.** She spearheads efforts to modernize and implement clean school infrastructure, upgrading public schools with energy-efficient facilities and transportation, reflecting her Senate policy priorities.
- **17.** Vice President Harris has cast a record number of tie-breaking votes in the Senate.
- 18. She led efforts on COVID-19 racial equity in the pandemic response.
- **19.** Juneteenth, which became a federal holiday during the Biden-Harris administration, was first introduced as a federal holiday by then-Senator Kamala Harris in 2020.
- **20.** Vice President Harris revived the push to make lynching a federal crime, successfully passing anti-lynching legislation in the Senate for the first time in 2018 after 200 failed attempts in prior Congresses. Under Biden-Harris, the Emmett Till Anti-Lynching Act made lynching a federal crime.
