The People's Path

An Exciting Opportunity to Bring Together the Community of Weston Green

The existing footpath that runs down the pond side of All Saints Weston church has been well used by people living in Weston Green and those visiting our parish for over 70 years. It now needs replacing. Over 1000 people visit our grounds each week and we want to offer anyone associated with the church an opportunity to leave their own special mark, in stone, on a new pathway.

Every brick of the new path will be engraved with the name of a person or place that's been important to someone in our community. But, it will be more than just a list of names: the path will serve as a historical record, a source of inspiration, a memory bank and a place of reflection for anyone working, living or visiting our parish. Ultimately it will weave the people from our village together within the sacred grounds of All Saints Weston and demonstrate that we recognise the stuff that is important in all our lives.

During a lifetime there are many memorable events and moments that shape who we are and All Saints Weston believes an engraved path will provide individuals and families with a way to celebrate in their own unique way. This could be by marking a birth, an anniversary, a significant event, commemorating a life or even celebrating your affinity with the parish of Weston.

Sponsorship costs £75 per brick, inclusive of engraving, but at this initial stage and because we expect the demand for bricks to be high, initially only five bricks are available per person. If this opportunity is of interest, we would advise you to consider placing an order quickly. Bricks will be offered on a first come, first served basis. In order to sponsor a brick the order form must be returned with your payment.

Frequently Asked Questions

Where are the bricks going to be located?

The 'People's Path' will run between the car park and the Garden of Remembrance on the pond side of the church and will totally replace the existing path. It will be formed of brand new, inscribed pavers.

How long will the bricks last?

All Saints Weston guarantees to maintain the Path for a minimum of 10 years.

How much are the sponsored bricks?

Sponsored bricks are priced at £75 each, regardless of quantity bought. Initially, you can sponsor a maximum of five bricks per individual. There will be a finite number of bricks available and we anticipate that they will go quickly. Bricks will be offered first to members of the Parochial Church Council, then to those on the All Saints Electoral Roll and then to anyone living within or working within the parish of Weston and anyone with a local connection.

If I order more than one brick, will these be placed together?

We will make every effort to place bricks together if you have indicated that this is your preference. There is a tick box on the order form that allows you to inform us if you would like your bricks placed near to each other.

How can I pay for my brick sponsorship?

You can pay in cash, by cheque or bank transfer. Please refer to the order form for exact details.

What is the benefit of Gift Aiding my donation – how does this work?

If you are a UK taxpayer, for every £1 you have donated to All Saints Weston we can claim 25p of Gift Aid tax relief and make your donations go further. All Saints Weston can claim Gift Aid tax relief of 25p on every £1 you give. All you need to do is complete the Gift Aid declaration box on the brick order form.

To qualify for Gift Aid, you must pay an amount of UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the appropriate tax year (currently 25p of each £1 given). If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief via your Self-Assessment tax return. Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate tax.

Will I own the brick once my sponsorship is finalised?

No. All bricks remain the sole property of All Saints Weston.

How will any surplus money raised from the People's Path be used?

Any surplus raised from brick sponsorship of the 'People's Path' will be utilised through the All Saints general fund to enrich our programme of activities that support our community.

It will enable the church to finish the restoration of our buildings and ensure we can provide our parish with safe spaces for spiritual nourishment and community groups such as the Beavers, Rainbows, Brownies, Cubs, Guides and Scouts.

We want All Saints Weston to be a place for all to enjoy, from the peace and serenity offered by the Edward Maufe designed building and grounds, to the activities we provide and to receive support from the outreach we deliver.

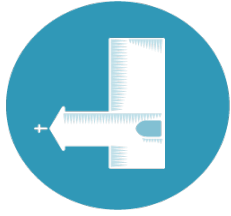

To place your brick sponsorship order, please complete the form below and return it by post or in person **with payment**, unless paying by bank transfer, in a firmly sealed envelope to:-

The Parish Office, All Saints Church, Chestnut Avenue, Esher, Surrey KT10 8JL. The parish office is inside the church and accessible when the church is open during daylight hours.

The outside of the envelope should be clearly marked **THE PEOPLE'S PATH** along with your **FULL NAME** in the top right hand corner. Please do not include any other parish correspondence in this envelope and do not staple cheques to any paperwork. You may photocopy the order form if required but please note we cannot accept photocopied signatures.

Your Inscription

Please write your name, date or message that you would like engraved in the boxes below. You may use up to 16 characters per line, including punctuation and spaces and with a maximum of 2 lines.

Please leave a blank space between each word. All inscriptions are automatically centred. You are only able to abbreviate via capital letters e.g. WG for Weston Green, B for Born, D for Died. No other character abbreviations can be used. You may use ' & ' for the word 'and', use a hyphen ' - ' or forward and back slashes ie ' / ' or ' \ ' plus ' x ' for kisses if you choose. Symbols cannot be accommodated ie ♡. All dates will be divided by dots, for example: 01.02.2012

We receive no government funding, no direct funding from the Church of England and have no significant endowments. We rely on the generosity of visitors, supporters and volunteers to enable us to maintain our magnificent building, provide high quality worship, engage in topical debate, develop new initiatives and hold fundraising events.

What can my engraved message say?

You can choose any tribute you like, from simply your name/ family's name, a special date such as a Baptism or graduation, or you could sponsor a brick on behalf of a business, club or society or to remember a loved one.

The choice of inscription is entirely up to you! The Path provides the opportunity for you to have your memory engraved onto a brick, which you can share with friends and family and enjoy for many years to come.

IMPORTANT - EVERY BRICK MUST CARRY A STAND ALONE INSCRIPTION. WE CANNOT ACCOMODATE TEXT IN THE FORM OF A MESSAGE SPREAD OVER MORE THAN ONE BRICK.

How many words or letters can I have?

Each brick allows 16 characters per line, which must include spaces and punctuation. All words must be divided by spaces. Each brick has a maximum of two lines available.

Can I use symbols or abbreviations?

You are welcome to use numbers where appropriate but you are only able to abbreviate via capital letters e.g. WG for Weston Green, B for Born, D for Died. No other character abbreviations can be used. You may use '&' for the word 'and', use a hyphen '-' and forward and back slashes ie '/' or '\' plus 'x' for kisses if you choose. Symbols cannot be accommodated ie.♥. All dates will be divided by dots, e.g. 01.02.2012

What colour will the engraving be?

The ink used in the engraving contains aluminium which will allow for wear and tear and longer life. As the bricks are a dark brown colour, we have chosen white ink which stands out more prominently and reflects the colour of the church.

What if I change my mind over the engraved text after I have placed my order?

Once you have placed your order we cannot offer an opportunity to change the text so please ensure you are happy BEFORE sending off your application.

Once we have received and accepted your order form we will forward you an acknowledgement by e mail or in person. If you do not receive this receipt within 21 days, please advise Ruth Bruce (contact details overleaf). Please note, All Saints Weston accepts no responsibility whatsoever for incorrect spellings, dates or other inscriptions.

Can I sponsor a brick in memory of someone?

The Path provides the opportunity for you to have any memory engraved into a brick; this includes remembering a loved one.

Can I sponsor a brick to remember a date, occasion or event?

The Path provides the opportunity for you to include any inscription. This could include an engagement, wedding anniversary, birthday, graduation, baptism or any event significant to you. Any memory or occasion can be engraved.

Do I have to be a member of All Saints congregation to sponsor a brick?

Not at all. The Path is open to everyone who has an association with Weston Green.

We would like as many people as possible to be represented. It is very much designed to be a path for all.

Can I sponsor a brick if I live abroad or if I am just visiting?

Yes. Anyone can sponsor a brick. We welcome international orders or orders from visitors. We already have enquiries from people now living in Canada and the United States.

When will the bricks be laid?

The bricks will be laid at Easter 2018 when the official launch and blessing of the Path will take place.

If I share my story with you what does this entail?

The order form allows you to tick a box to share your story. This means that our Press and PR team will contact you for details on why you are engraving a brick.

Your story may then be used by the church for marketing purposes; either in local press articles or via All Saints marketing initiatives. We will seek further, direct permission before using any personal stories.
