

# Did you know...

There are over 700 varieties of pumpkins

Here at the Cullen Pumpkin Farm we plant 100 varieties!

We plant pumpkin, gourd, and squash seeds in trays and grow them in a greenhouse for the first month

We plant 25,000 seeds by hand!

We then must transplant the seedlings with a special transplanter

It takes us a week!

We rotate the fields every year to give the land a break

Have you noticed?

We have Bees to pollinate the plants

They are delivered in June and picked up in September. The Bees will be moved to Georgia to help pollinate Pecans!

The Corn Maze is hand cut every year in July. The last few years there has been a lot of damage to the corn maze.

We make it different so you can't cheat!

The Wagon Ride is run by one of the brothers

He gives you a history of the farm during the ride

The Cullen Pumpkin Farm is family owned and has been in operation since 1982

Before we were a Pumpkin Farm we were a Dairy Farm!

This is a yearlong commitment

We plan, order, sort, plow the fields, plant seeds, prepare the fields, transplant the seedlings, plant the corn maze and specialty corn, spray for bugs, spray for weeds, cut the corn maze, watch them grow, set up the lots with fences, decorations, plan the weekend activities, pick smaller gourds and pumpkins, cut the you pick pumpkins, and work the weekends through the season.
