The ideal response time goal of 6 minutes and 20 seconds meets the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) recommend standard (NFPA 1710).

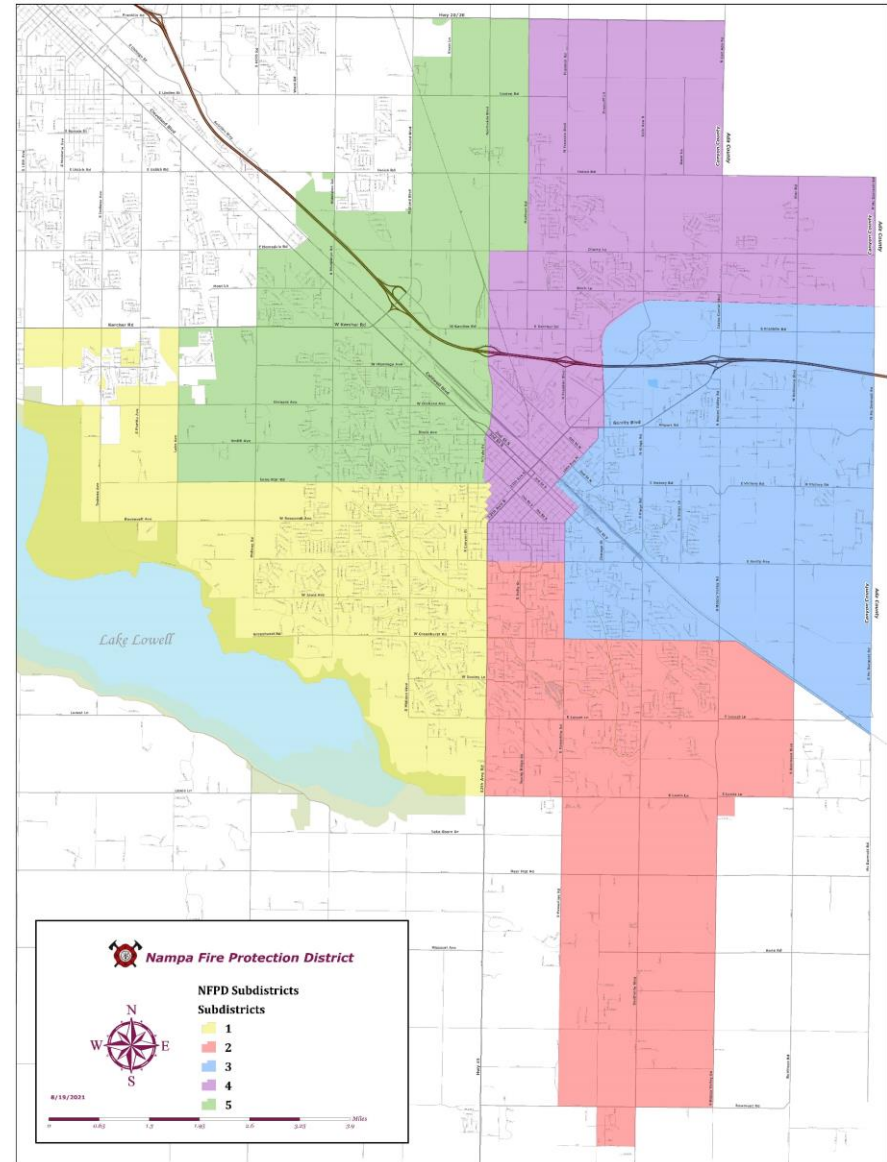
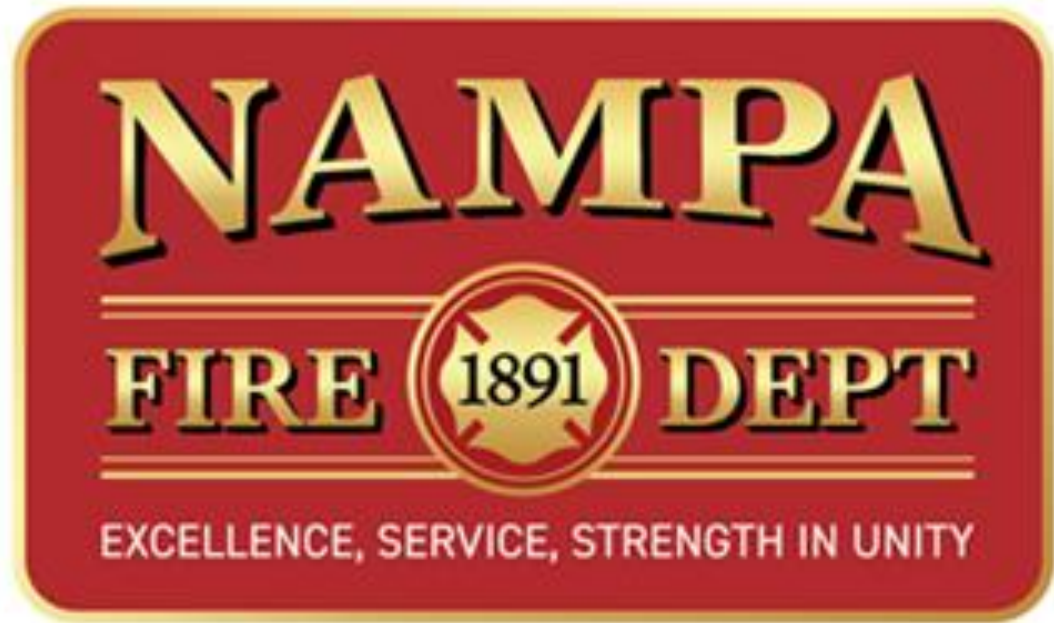

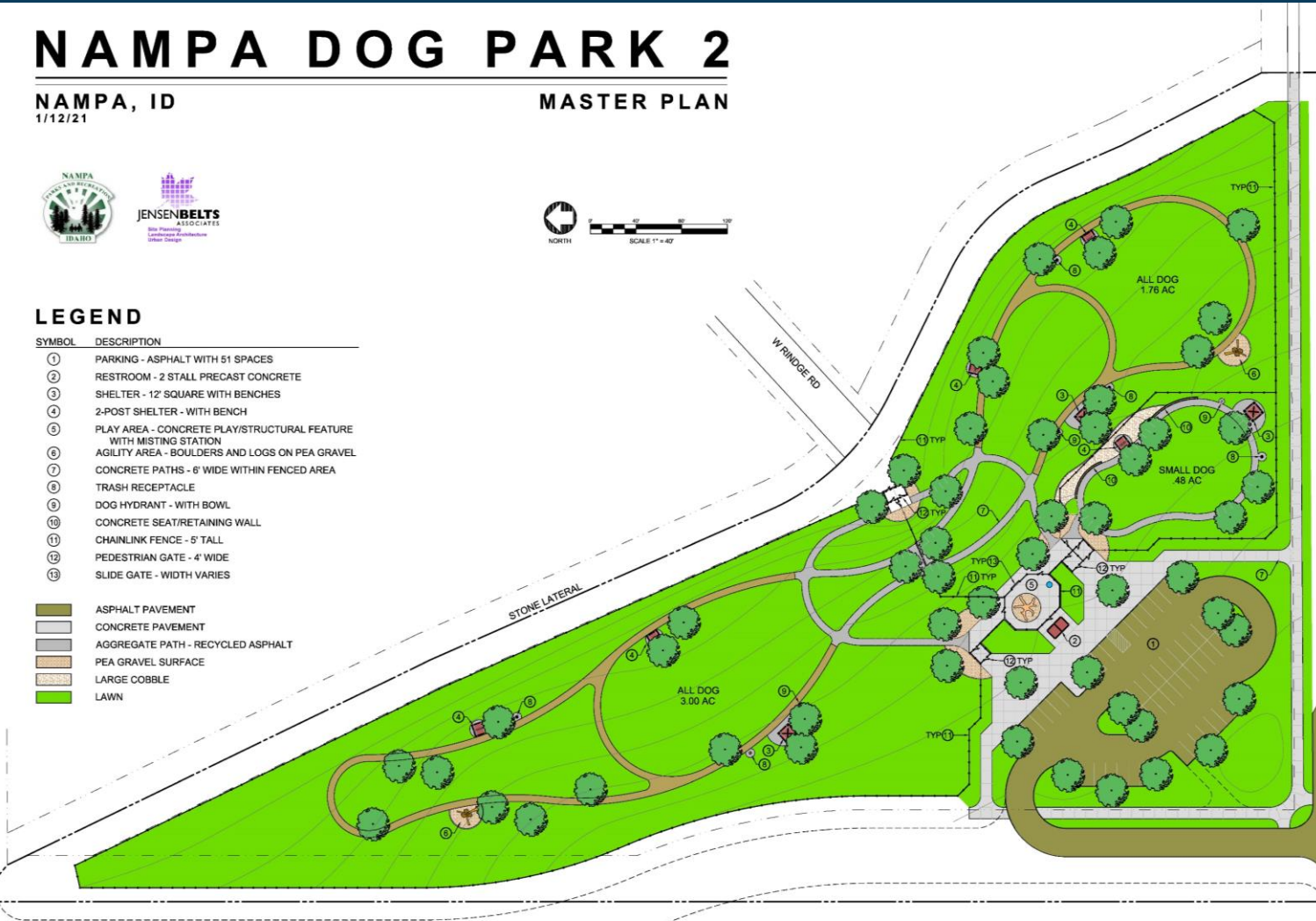
