Judged from the paintings SUBMITTED FOR ART AUCTION ONLY of each participating artist. This event is a fundraiser for HMA, c/o The Art Bar San Francisco, and it will retain a minimum of 1 artwork from each participating artist for art auction. Bidding will start at \$200 per piece.

ACCEPTED WORK INFORMATION: Submission Deadline: SEPT 5. Acceptance status notification will be sent by MIDNIGHT September 6, 2019.

ART CONDITION: Artwork must be clean, framed, wired and ready to hang or place on a base. Paint and any other materials must be dry.

LABELING: Please label each artwork on the back or bottom of the piece with your name, phone #, email address, title of the work, medium, dimensions and price or (nfs).

SALES: Work will be for sale at the price indicated by the artist upon submission of entry, plus tax. Sale of artwork is subject to gallery's commission until the end of the exhibit. Artists who donate to silent auction, receive 80% from final sale price.

DROPOFF: Artwork must be hand-delivered to Gala Director of Arts & Exhibitions; Curator, Mishel Narvaez on September 20, 2019, between 6am-6pm. NO EXCEPTIONS. Artists will be sent email with drop off address for artworks once confirmed.

Marketing Materials: ie; business cards, brochures, stickers, etc. Artists can drop off any and all marketing materials at time of drop-off of their artworks. All marketing materials will be located in *designated areas only.

Artist Vendors: Artists interested in bringing their own 10'x10' pop-up canopy, will be required to set up their tent outside in common area near events outdoor seating areas 1 day prior to event. Tents exteriors must be white, clean, clear of any markings or signages. All art/materials must be kept inside of tent. Extension cords and extra lighting are welcome, however no tables or seating on exterior sides of tents. Vendors receive 100% profits of all sales. Booth rentals are \$100 per tent or \$200 with tent provided*** PLEASE MAKE SURE TENT IS APPROVED PRIOR TO EVENT DAY***
