


The Health Care Safety Net: Finding a Medical Home in Metro Atlanta

The *Health Care Safety Net* is a name for those health care providers who provide health care and other health-related services to the uninsured or to Medicaid patients. A *Medical Home* is a way to deliver coordinated, team-based, primary health care with the goal of preventing illness and maximizing health.
