FROM THE COMMUNITY SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

John 10:11-18

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand, who is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away—and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. The hired hand runs away because a hired hand does not care for the sheep.

I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. And I lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd.

For this reason, the Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it up again. I have received this command from my Father." John 10:11-18

"The good shepherd", what a comforting image that portrays. God loves us unconditionally. He loves us not because it is his job, but because we are his children.

I cannot help but think about the love God has for me and the love that God has for you. I think it could be compared to the love for children and grandchildren. This love exists no matter the challenges that are presented or the daily tasks to be accomplished. I love Veronica and she loves me not because we are married, but because we have a deep meaningful relationship. This is the kind of relationship God wants with us. The image of the shepherd caring for the flock is the image of a love God caring for his creation. This gives me hope for each day!

Just as Jesus ran to his flock when the wolf came, we, as brothers and sisters in Christ run to each other and we are confident in the one who looks out for us and is always willing to come running to protect us.

God also spoke of loving people that are 'not of our fold'. We are taught to love God and to love our neighbor. This is the hard part. I love my family and my church family, but can I always love my neighbor?

As Christians, we are called to evangelize and spread the Gospel. What could be a better way to do so than to love others? We are reminded that the love of God is eternal. We are called to love others as he loves us. God loves all of his sheep.


