

"So, the Lord saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians dead on the seashore. Thus, Israel saw the great work which the Lord had done in Egypt; so, the people feared the Lord, and believed the Lord and His servant Moses." Exodus 14:30 – 31

Here we are in July already and we know the fireworks are about to begin. The fourth of July, known to us in the United States to be declared "Independence Day." We know there were some enemies that needed to be defeated for us to have the freedom that our wonderful country has experienced. 
