Any Questions?

I know in June we celebrate "Father's Day," and I was leaning toward doing a devotion on that subject, but I also know that we experienced the "Day of Deeper Understanding," in May. I am sure that all the pilgrims that came got all their questions answered and they are all prepared for their "Fourth Day."

No, I am sure of the opposite outcome. There were pilgrims there, and those that have been there more than one time to gain knowledge or as we say a "Deeper Understanding of the Emmaus Walk," that have questions. I am not saying that knowledge and understanding was not accomplished, but all of us walked away from that day wishing I had asked a question. Jesus taught His disciples everyday on the road and they learned at lot about life along the way, but they gained more from asking Jesus questions. Just ask yourself, "Is it not true that when I ask specific questions, I remember the answer even longer than other information I receive. The disciples asked Jesus about parables, divorce, the man being born blind, the destruction of Jerusalem, and about His return. When they failed to be able to cast out a demon, they asked Jesus why? And yes, they asked Jesus to teach them to pray.

Now, I know that those questions are not the questions that you may have, but do you have any questions, especially questions that would keep you from becoming more involved in the Emmaus Community? Here is the kind of questions I am talking about, "How far do I have to travel to team and how do teamers travel?' Answer: Teamers will look for others to ride with and arrange a meeting place to park and ride. "How do you afford to pay for teaming and sponsoring someone? I have limited income?" Answer: I have a jar, no correction a Cheese Puff plastic container. When I get extra money from filling the pulpit or driving for Cancer Patients put the money in the container apart from my regular monthly budget. When I was working, if I made \$587.00 in my paycheck, I would take the \$7.00 and put it in the container." You can put your own twist, but a little at a time is easier to deal with than the full amount at the time of teaming and sponsoring.

Emmaus is never a replacement for church. Anyone you are considering sponsoring should be active in a home church or actively seeking achurch home.

There is a \$200 fee for each pilgrim. It is your choice if you ask your pilgrim to pay the \$50.00 application fee (which is non refundable) and there is up to \$75.00 scholarship available for a pilgrim which must be requested from the Pre-weekend chairperson.

You need to make arrangements for your pilgrim to have dinner the night the walk begins and have them at the camp NO Earlier then 6:30. Plan to be at Sponsor's hour to pray for them and at all special activities.

Contact their family to have them provide letters of affirmation to be given in their Agape bags.


