2026 License Agreements

New license agreements were sent out at the end of September. Please note the **new license amount is \$1,525**, due for the 2026 season.

When submitting your signed License Agreement, please include the following:

- Payment
- Copy of your insurance declaration page (proof of insurance)
- Copy of your driver's license

Pet Owners - Important Notice

If you have a pet, you must submit:

• A new vaccination form

Updated proof of insurance

Due Date: April 11, 2026 (Site Selection Day)(please do not submit prior to this date)

Electricity Rate Update

The Board has approved a rate increase for electricity:

- From \$0.15 per kWh to \$0.20 per kWh, effective immediately
- The minimum charge (if no electricity is used) will increase from \$10 to \$25

Off-Season Project: We are realigning the Boat Storage lots. If you have a boat and trailer, or utility trailer, etc, please move it off the storage lot by October 31st. You may store your boat or utility trailer at your site until spring,

Water Turn-Off Day

We will begin turning off water for the season on Saturday, November 8th at 9:00 AM. If you'd like to volunteer or observe the process, please meet at the Port Office.

Reminder: While residents are welcome year-round, please note:

All water lines will be drained and shut off

Do not dispose of gray or black water during the off-season due to potential frost damage Please use antifreeze in your tanks to prevent freezing

Trailer Requests – Off-Season Guidelines

If you're planning to purchase a trailer during the off-season, please note:

Trailers 36 ft and over may take additional time for approval

- No trailer deliveries are permitted during the off-season
- New trailers can be delivered on Trailer Moving Day: April 18, 2026
- If delivery is after April 18, you must:
 - i. Provide two weeks' notice
 - ii. Submit two possible dates/times
 - iii.Ensure a Board member is present

If purchasing a trailer from another Port resident, you still need to submit a Trailer Request Form for record-keeping. You are financially responsible for moving the trailer to your site, and a Board member must be present.


